Angelo RC Receives Letter of Authorization for Increased Altitude Ops by Gary Jones


ARC Safety Office Gary Jones has posted the Letter of Authorization that allows our flight operations to increase from our 400 Foot Limit now to 700 Feet. This is especially great for our glider pilots and those with larger aircraft. The letter has been posted to the Club Bulletin Board at the field.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. CONTACT INFORMATION:

- Lucas Rodden is the person responsible for the implementation and administration of this Authorization on behalf of AMA. The overall safety of each unmanned aircraft system (UAS) operation under this Certificate of Authorization remains with the individual operator of the UAS in accordance with 49 USC 44809.
- The aviation event director is responsible for the overall compliance with the AMA's safety guidelines for any aviation events i.e. airshows, air races, etc.

2. FLIGHT OPERATIONS:

- Unmanned aircraft operations are permitted up to the maximum altitude of Class G airspace based on FAA aeronautical charts, 700ft or up to 1200ft AGL as applicable. See Attachment 1 for specific altitudes authorized at specific sites. "Ground level" begins at the Earth's surface and does not include man-made structures, trees, or any obstacle. The applicable 700ft or 1200ft AGL altitudes are an absolute value and shall not be added to the height of any structures or obstacles.
- This Certificate of Authorization, including the Special Provisions, is limited in effect to the hours between civil sunrise and civil sunset local time. Night-time operations are authorized only up to 400ft AGL and in accordance with AMA guidelines.
- The responsible person must ensure all AMA members and AMA club officers are familiar with and comply with the responsibilities and procedures in this authorization.
- The responsible person must ensure all AMA rules and applicable safety guidelines are used by all participants and enforced by AMA officials.
- AMA, in accordance with its established safety guidelines, must request a NOTAM covering operations at fixed sites prior to any AMA-aviation event permitted at fixed sites by this Authorization. Such events are not authorized until FAA issues an appropriate NOTAM in response to AMA's request.
- Aviation events operating under this Authorization must have 3 miles of visibility and a ceiling of 3000ft AGL or greater.
- All operations must be within VLOS of the fixed site reference point (See Attachment 1) and conform to all applicable federal, state, and local governmental laws and regulations.
- For operations at fixed sites within 2nm of an airport in Class G airspace, the AMA must have a letter of agreement with the airport owner/operator.

regarding the conduct of AMA operations.

- The responsible person must ensure AMA members are briefed for awareness of possible increased aviation activity in the area before conducting operations at fixed sites within 2nm of charted manned aeronautical activities.
- The responsible person must ensure AMA members are briefed on any operational limitations based on fixed site field size, location, and proximity to congested areas.
- If a conflict exists between this Authorization and any other guidance governing recreational operations, the more restrictive provisions will apply.
- Any modifications, additions, or deletions to Attachment 1 must be submitted as an amendment through DroneZone. Please reference this authorization number when submitting any amendment.
